This rate is available to all domestic, commercial, and governmental customers not covered by any other special rates in this schedule.

Consumption Charges

For the first	1,200 Cu. Ft. or less	\$76.93	minimum per quarter
For the next	6,000 Cu Ft. per quarter	\$3.88	per 100 cubic feet
Excess of	7,200 Cu. Ft. per quarter	\$2.59	per 100 cubic feet
For the first	400 Cu. Ft. or less	\$25.64	minimum per month
For the next	2,000 Cu. Ft. per month	\$3.88	per 100 cubic feet
Excess of	2,400 Cu. Ft. per month	\$2.59	per 100 cubic feet

Minimum Charge

Public Fire Protection

Available:

To the Towns of Jackman and Moose River for municipal fire protection.

Rate:

Jackman:

For the existing public hydrants as installed October 1, 2026, a fire protection charge of:

\$69,111.35 Annually

\$17,277.84 Quarterly

Moose River:

For the existing public hydrants as installed October 1, 2026, a fire protection charge of:

\$8,916.78 Annually

\$2,229.19 Quarterly

Rate for hydrants installed after October 1, 2026 shall be determined in accordance with the Public Utilities Commission Rules and Regulations Chapter 69.

All public fire hydrants now existing or to be installed will be cared for and maintained in good working order (unavoidable accidents excepted) by the District. Once any fire hydrant is actually installed and in operation, the total annual fire protection service charge then in effect will not be reduced should the municipality served order one or more hydrants discontinued.

Should the municipality served order any hydrant or hydrants moved to a different location, the municipality served shall pay to the District all costs of moving said hydrant or hydrants.

Terms of Payment:

To be billed, and paid quarterly in advance on January, April, July, and October 1.

Private Fire Protection

Available:

To customers using the utilities service for private fire protection. The following rates apply to fire protection only and include no allowance for water for other than fire fighting purposes.

Rate:

For each 4" service line per annum \$1069.21

For each 6" service line per annum \$1603.16

For each 8" service line per annum \$2137.12

There will be no charge in addition to this for sprinkler heads or private fire hydrants.

Terms of Payment:

To be billed and paid quarterly in advance on January, April, July, and October 1.

Note: The Utility reserves the right to meter any fire line where it has reason to believe that water is being taken from the line for purposes other than fire service. Water so metered shall be billed in accordance with the regular filed rates in Sheet#1 in addition to the above rates.

Quarterly Billings

Base Rate, Minimum and Readiness to Serve:

0 to 1200 cubic feet	each 100 c.f. over 1200 c.f.
\$79.00	\$6.50

A "Base Rate, "Minimum" or "Readiness to Serve" charge, shall be assessed to each Unit approved by the Board of Trustees for connection into the Jackman Utility District-Sewer Division. Any property approved for connection by the Board of Trustees shall be assessed the "Readiness to Serve" charge for each Unit approved, whether actually connected to the system or not.
